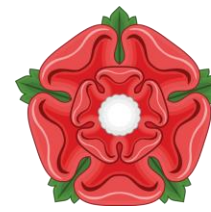

Key Facts

- Sewing is the craft of fastening or attaching objects using stitches made with a sewing needle and thread. It is one of the oldest of the textile arts.
- Sewing lets you express yourself through your creations, but it can also be functional - fixing clothing and cloth.

Influence

The Tudor rose is the name given to the combined emblems of the York and Lancastrian families, who fought each other for control of the English throne from 1455-1487 in what became known as 'The Wars of the Roses'.
