Pounds and Pence



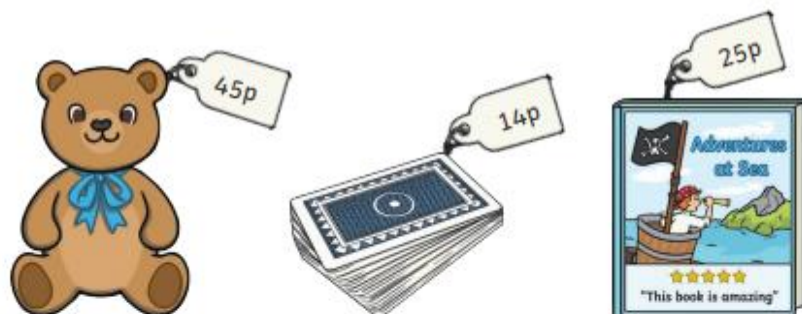
Pence and pounds

Equal amounts

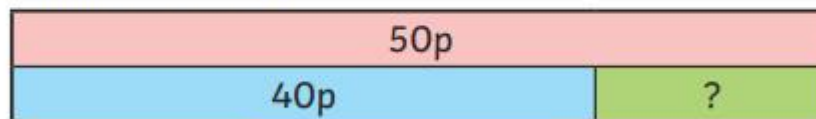


$$£1 = £1 = £1$$
