We thought about and discussed who we are to different people but that we are the same person. From this we were able to make links with Christians who belong to the Church of England and Christians who belong to the Catholic faith.

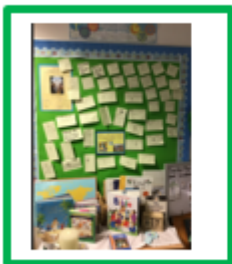
Christianity as a global faith
