As part of our topic, you will be taking on a creative homework project that lets you explore Roman life in fun and imaginative ways. Whether you enjoy building, drawing, writing stories, or making things, there will be plenty of exciting activities to choose from. The goal is to help you learn more about how the Romans lived, worked and changed history—while showing off your creativity and brilliant ideas!

ART & CREATIVITY

Design and decorate your own Roman shield.

Make a Roman mosaic using paper squares, pasta or beads.

Create your own Roman artefact (coin, brooch, bracelet or helmet).

Perform a short Roman play or act out a Roman scene.

MAKING & BUILDING

Build a mini Roman villa from a shoebox, Lego or recycled materials.

Build a working Roman catapult using lolly sticks and elastic bands.

Make a cross-section model of a Roman road.

Create a Roman-style musical instrument and play a marching rhythm.

RESEARCH & THINKING

Make a fact poster about a famous Roman (e.g. Julius Caesar, Boudicca).

Draw a map of the Roman Empire including key cities.
Invent your own Roman god or goddess with special powers.

Research Roman life in Britain and present 5 surprising facts.
