Key Vocabulary

Muslim	A person who follows Islam
Allah	Allah, the one and only God in Islam
Shahadah	The Shahadah is the Muslim declaration of faith and the first Pillar of Islam
Holy Qur'an	A very special book for Muslims
Prophet	A religious leader who passed on God's teachings

Key Knowledge

- Muslims are followers of Islam and their God is called Allah.
- The Prophet Muhammed was a teacher who shared Allah's important messages and stories with Muslims.
- When Muslims talk about the Prophet Muhammed, they also say 'peace be upon him' to show he was very special.
- Muslims do not draw pictures of Allah or the Prophet Muhammed, but they use calligraphy instead.
