



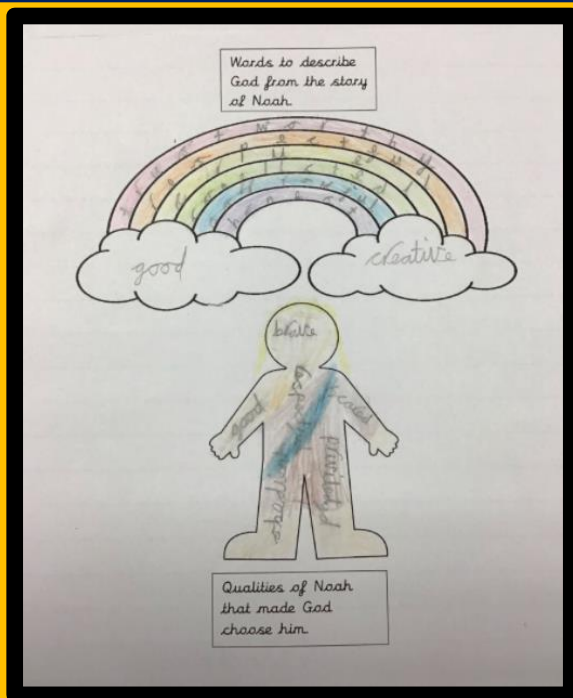
A journey of learning in the light of God's love
