



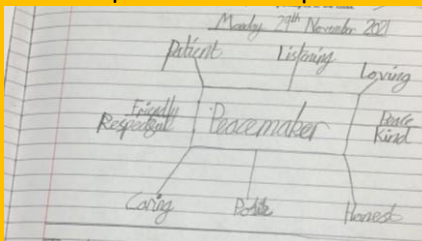

## Was Jesus the Messiah?

*During this half term the children have been learning about what we mean by the term 'messiah'. We have explored the life of Jesus and how Jesus is represented in the Bible. We have focused on how many Christians believe that Jesus was the Messiah. We have also debated what it means to be a 'peacemaker'. We then discussed if there is a need for a messiah today and that if God was to send a messiah today what would they be like.*

We have thought about what it means to be a 'peacemaker' and the qualities that a peacemaker might possess.



We have spent time creating our own messiah. We had some great discussions about the qualities that a messiah might possess and the actions that they may take to spread their message. We explained how our messiahs might tell us to care for the environment and to love one another.
