We have also been linking the creation story to the Christian value of love and respect because we think everyone should love and respect all of the creations in the world.



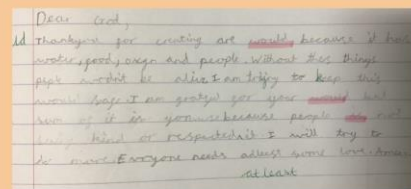
We explored our wondrous world whilst on a nature walk. We took this time to focus on the creations that we see everyday. We thought about how these creations appeared.



We expressed our feelings about the world through music and art. We listened to the lyrics of a popular song called 'What a Wonderful World' and expressed different creations through colours, shapes and pictures.



We have explored the creation story, thinking about how the world was created over seven days. We linked our knowledge of the creation story with the big frieze.



We considered how wonderful our world is. We thought about some questions we had about our world and how thankful we are for it. We showed our gratitude by writing a prayer about the different creations in the world.
