During this half term, the children have started learning about the faith of Islam. Year One will continue with their learning during the first half of the summer term.

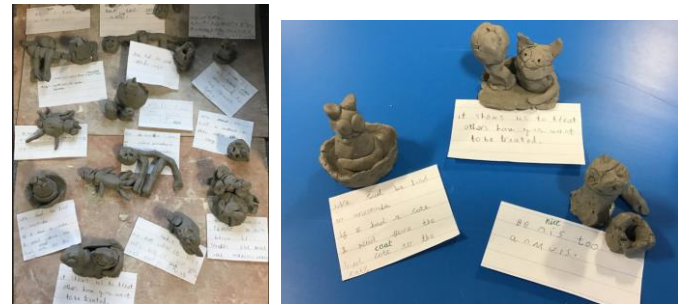
Muslims beliefs about God.

The children listened to the story of 'Muhammad and the cat'. The children discussed the meaning of the story and how important it is to many Muslims.

Whispering the Adhan

The children have started learning about the five pillars of Islam. They have looked at the first pillar and the words of the Shahadah. The words of the Shahadah are included in the words that are whispered into the ear of a baby when they are first born.



The children thought about whispering to a baby and they chose words they could whisper. The children then whispered these words to one another. The children were able to think carefully about the importance of words.
