faith	A complete trust or confidence in someone or something
belief	An acceptance that something exists

- Values are important to most people, whether they believe in God or not.

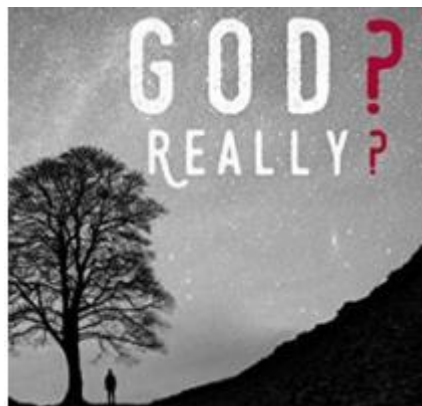
Key Questions
