| <b>Torah</b>         | First part of the Jewish holy book which refers to the five books of Moses |
| <b>Torah scroll</b>  | The Torah that is read in the synagogue is written on a scroll             |
| <b>Shema</b>         | An important Jewish prayer found inside the Torah                          |
| <b>Rabbi</b>         | A Jewish teacher who is often the Religious Leader                         |
| <b>Mezuzah</b>       | A small scroll with some carefully written words from the Torah            |

- Jewish people believe in one God.
- Some Jewish people remember God in different ways.
- The mezuzah in the home reminds Jewish people about God.
- Shabbat is a special day of the week for Jewish people. It is the weekly day of rest which starts at sunset on Friday and lasts until sunset on Saturday
- The festival of Hanukkah is very important to Jewish people where they celebrate one of the greatest miracles in Jewish History.
